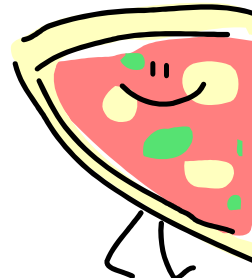
FINGERPRINTING & VIRTUS TRAINING
